

- 8.7** **Charges** (En 5 Jun 75)
- 8.7.1** This committee consists of seven members. (Am Nov 02)
- 8.7.2** Five members shall constitute a quorum.
- 8.7.3** It is the duty of this committee to:
- 8.7.3.1** Receive in writing, through the Chancellor, unresolved complaints regarding Faculty conduct;
- 8.7.3.2** Determine whether the allegations in the complaint, if true, would constitute a violation of University policy regulating individual Faculty conduct; and
- 8.7.3.3** If answered negatively, recommend to the Chancellor that all references to the complaint shall be expunged from all records except that of the Charges Committee;
- 8.7.3.4** If answered affirmatively, request from the Chancellor any supporting evidence already developed and conduct an investigation to determine if there is probable cause to warrant a disciplinary hearing before the Committee on Privilege and Tenure. The findings shall be submitted to the Chancellor. (Am 31 May 79)
- 8.7.4** The committee may appoint *ad hoc* hearing committees.
